Hello Fellow members and Friends of JUCC!

It's hard to believe that the end of April is upon us and a third of 2019 has gone by. Time certainly does seem to fly!

At this time on our church calendar, we have gone through Holy Easter week, and what a wonderful, enriching experience our Easter week has been. Pastor Kathryn certainly was very busy preparing for and leading us in five extraordinary services - Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and three Easter Sunday Services. Each service provided its own unique meaning to Easter week. Thank you, Pastor, for all of your passion in leading us on our faith journey.

Our weekly bible study group has taken a short break over the Easter season, but there does appear to be great interest in getting together again soon. Our hope is to resume the study on Thursday, May 9th. Please watch your bulletin announcements for more information.

Finally, a quick update on the progress of our church building addition. We met with our architect and mechanical engineer on Monday, April 22nd. The structural plans are complete and the mechanical plans are 95% complete. The last plan we are waiting for is the land plan. This plan entails the design for the new septic system, parking area, storm water run-off, and exterior lighting. We hope to have this plan completed shortly. We will then put bid packages together to secure three (3) bids and proceed to evaluate and select our contractor. Updates on this process will be forthcoming as information is available. We will do our best to keep this process moving forward.

There are so many things happening, and much to look forward to as spring and summer arrive.
