## Christian Education- January 2021

Sunday School continues to meet on Zoom on Sunday mornings at 9:30. There are 9 kiddos that have signed onto the classes 6 of whom are regular attendees.

During our time we discussed in great detail: Abraham, Jacob, Joseph, David and most recently, Mary, Joseph, The Inn Keeper, The Shepherds and the angels, which all lead up to a reprise showing of last year's program "A Star is Born" We really covered the importance of Jesus' birth.
