MESSAGE FROM THE CONSISTORY PRESIDENT **NOVEMBER 2021**



Hello Fellow Church Members and Future Church Members:

Here we are again, another month has almost gone by. It seems like I just did my monthly letter, but October is almost over and I'm writing it again. We agreed at our monthly consistory meeting to move inside the Church for Sunday services due to the chilly and damp mornings in the grove. We were hoping to have at least one more outside service in October, so we could see the nice fall foliage, but will have to see if that happens. We had our Apple Fest in the beginning of October, with a very good turn-out. There were a whole lot of people helping out that day. Dean Hahn and Lisa Hawk did a great job, and the people came out to hear them play and sing, eat some good food, and take their chances on our meat raffle and Chinese auction. This year was one of our best Apple Fest fundraisers that we ever had. Thanks to all that came out and helped, and those that came to support our Church too! The Search Committee had three pastors inquire about the position at our Church. We have heard back from two of them, and interviewed them online. We are hoping to get some more applicants, as the search continues. Pastor Quayle is doing a great job for us, and said he was in no hurry to go anywhere, and will be with us through the winter months and into the spring for sure. We can take our time and find the person who is the right fit for our Church, without taking the first person that comes along. We had our cemetery cleanup with a good group of members turning out to help with that. We are working on our future building project continuously. All land plans were approved, signed, and being recorded at the courthouse this week. We are in contact with our township zoning officer, and finalizing the architect prints so we can get our building permits, and move forward on that exciting project for the future of our Church. We are also having a Thanksgiving filling sale, with orders due to the Church office by November 13th. We are going to be cutting off our orders once we have 1,000 pounds sold for this year, so if you haven't ordered yet and would like to do so, don't wait. There are a lot of mission projects going on this time of year at our Church, so check the upcoming newsletters for details: ready-to-prepare Thanksgiving & Christmas Dinners, Operation Warm a Child (new or used children's coats), Operation Christmas Child, Shut-In Boxes. You can donate to any of these worthwhile causes. I know it's only the end of October, but we are planning to have two Christmas Eve services for this year. We are going to try to do one at 5 p.m. in the Grove, and 7 p.m. in the Sanctuary, so mark your calendars. We have a lot of people in our Church family in need of your prayers, so please pray for them. Also, mark your calendars for the last Sunday in November. Our Annual Meeting will take place on November 28th, at 9:30 a.m., right before our 10 a.m. service. We will be voting on our 2022 Proposed Budget, along with nominating and electing new consistory members. If anyone is interested in serving on consistory, please get in touch with either myself or any of the other consistory members. Hope to see you in Church over the next few months.


