Hello Fellow Members and Friends,

I am glad to report we are finally moving in a positive direction with our church addition. The first stage of the land development is completed. This included the installation of the storm water retention basin and the sand mound for the new septic system. This work was completed in a very timely manner and on budget.

We will be finalizing the building construction contract very shortly. Due to inflationary pressures and material supply issues in the construction market, we have experienced a substantial increase in our budget since the original contract proposal. We have been working very closely with our contractor to find areas to reduce costs. Fortunately, we have had some success and will continue to work at reducing costs. Our contractor has been very receptive and open to working with us to accomplish more cost reductions. We are expecting building construction to begin sometime in June.

We are in a very sound position financially, but will need to borrow more money from the bank then we were initially planning to do. Thankfully, the building pledge campaign last month has added additional dollars to the building fund account. We want to thank all of you for your generous financial support. Every dollar helps. We will be finalizing our mortgage terms with the bank very shortly. That's all for now. More updates to follow.
